# **Constitution of Catalyst Fellowship**

## Updated as of April 26, 2025

### **Article I: Name and Purpose**

- 1.1 The official name of the Campus Group will be Catalyst Fellowship.
- 1.2 The campus group may be referred to by the acronym CF.
- 1.3 The purpose, objectives, mission, and/or mandate of the organization is to preach the Gospel and make disciples in universities and colleges through vibrant, Christ-centered, and discipleship-focused fellowship. Catalyst Fellowship aims to foster spiritual growth and a faith-based community within the University of Toronto Scarborough.
- 1.4 Catalyst Fellowship fundamentally serves a non-profit function within the University of Toronto Scarborough and will not engage in essentially commercial activities.
- 1.5 Catalyst Fellowship operates as an independent entity working within the University of Toronto Scarborough community, subject to the values and policies of the University.

### **Article II: Membership**

- **2.1** Membership is open to all students, staff, faculty, and alumni of the University of Toronto Scarborough.
- **2.2** Voting membership is open only to registered students of the University of Toronto.
- **2.3** Non-voting membership is open to University of Toronto staff, faculty, alumni, and persons from outside the University. Non-voting members do not hold voting rights unless otherwise stated.
- **2.4** The term of membership will be from September 1 to August 31 of each year.
- **2.5** Catalyst Fellowship will not collect a mandatory membership fee.
- **2.6** Catalyst Fellowship values and protects the personal information of its members and will use it only for internal purposes related to the delivery of services.

# **Article III: Rights of Members**

- **3.1** All voting members have the right to:
  - Participate and vote in group elections and meetings
  - Communicate and explore all ideas
  - Organize or engage in reasonable and lawful activities/events
  - Freedom from discrimination based on sex, race, religion, or sexual orientation
  - Freedom from censorship or interference by the University unless activities become unlawful
  - Distribute published material on campus, provided it is lawful
- **3.2** All members have the responsibility to:
  - Support the purpose and values of Catalyst Fellowship
  - Contribute constructively to programs and activities
  - Attend general meetings
  - Respect peers and fellow members
  - Abide by the constitution, University policies, and applicable laws

### **Article IV: Executive Committee**

- **4.1** The Executive Committee shall consist of:
  - Coordinator
  - Outreach & Social Media Lead
  - Treasurer
  - Events Lead
- **4.2** The term for all positions on the Executive Committee shall be from May 1st to April 30th.
- **4.3** Only voting members (currently registered students) may hold voting positions on the Executive Committee
- **4.4** Non-voting members may hold non-voting positions if any are created, but cannot serve as financial authority, signing authority, or primary/secondary contact.
- **4.5** Executive Committee Roles:
  - Coordinator:

- Provides vision and leadership
- Acts as the official spokesperson
- Ensures activities align with CF's purpose and values
- o Facilitates meetings and decision-making

## • Outreach & Social Media Lead:

- Manages partnerships and external relations
- Oversees event planning and promotions
- Handles social media and communications
- Supports outreach initiatives

#### • Treasurer:

- Maintains accurate financial records
- o Manages the group's budget, expenses, and funding
- Prepares and presents financial reports to the Executive Committee
- Ensures compliance with financial regulations

### • Events Lead:

- Assists the Outreach & Social Media Lead with planning and executing events
- o Coordinates logistics for activities, workshops, and social gatherings
- Supports member engagement through event initiatives
- **4.6** Directors or Coordinators for various committees may be appointed, but will not have executive decision-making authority unless otherwise specified.

#### **Article V: Elections**

- 5.1 All voting positions on the Executive Committee shall be filled through an annual election.
- 5.2 All voting members are eligible to seek nomination and cast a ballot.
- 5.3 Non-voting members may only seek non-voting positions if any exist.
- 5.4 Elections must be conducted in a non-biased manner.
- 5.5 The nominee receiving the plurality of votes will be declared the winner.
- 5.6 In case of multiple vacancies, candidates with the highest number of votes will fill the positions.
- 5.7 If a position remains vacant, duties will be shared among the remaining officers until filled via a by-election.

# **Article VI: Termination of Membership**

- 6.1 Membership or leadership removal may be initiated if a member/leader:
  - Engages in unlawful activities
  - Violates the constitution or University policies
  - Infringes upon the rights of others
  - Fails to fulfill organizational responsibilities
- 6.2 The removal process:
  - First Tier: Verbal and written warning
  - Second Tier: Written corrective action plan (14-day period to improve)
  - Third Tier: Vote for removal by a two-thirds (2/3) majority at a valid general meeting
- 6.3 A member or leader has the right to speak at their removal hearing.

### **Article VII: Finances**

- 7.1 Catalyst Fellowship's funds shall be expended according to an approved operating budget.
- 7.2 Unbudgeted expenses over \$100 must be approved at a general meeting.
- **7.3** The Coordinator shall prepare and present the budget in collaboration with the Treasurer.
- 7.4 The operating budget must be approved by a majority of voting members present.
- **7.5** The Coordinator and Treasurer will act as signing authorities.
- **7.6** Accurate financial records must be maintained and passed on to the incoming leadership.
- 7.7 Catalyst Fellowship accepts full financial and production responsibility for its activities...

#### **Article VIII: Amendments**

- 8.1 Amendments to this constitution require a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote at a general meeting.
- 8.2 All voting members may propose and vote on constitutional amendments.

- 8.3 The Executive Committee must submit the revised constitution to the Student Life programs office within two (2) weeks.
- 8.4 Amendments take effect only after being approved by the Student Life programs office.

## **Article IX: Additional Policies**

Catalyst Fellowship must comply with:
